

# Travel schedule and guideline

## 9<sup>th</sup> Dec, 2009

- 11.00 - 12.30 Lunch
- 12.30 - 14.00 Travel from Chulalongkorn University to Vimanmek Mansion by bus
- 14.00 - 16.00 Visit at Vimanmek Mansion
- 16.00 - 17.00 Travel to Suan Lum Night Bazaar
- 17.00 Shopping at Suan Lum Night Bazaar and go to Bangkok Centre Hotel by MRT.



Billed as the world's largest teakwood building, Vimanmek Mansion was built as a royal residence in the first few years of the 20th century. It was only used for a few years before it fell into disuse and was practically forgotten until the early eighties. It was rediscovered by Her Majesty the Queen and turned into museum reflecting the Thai heritage from the dramatic reign of King Rama V.

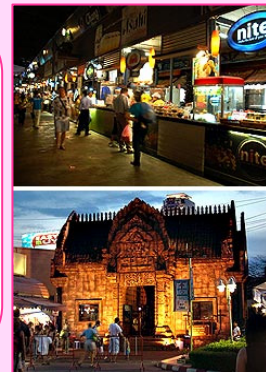
For visiting at Vimanmek Mansion, please note that:

- Men must wear long pants and sleeved shirts.  
Women must wear skirts or pants extending at least to the knee, and also should not sport bare shoulders.
- You can take as many pictures outside, but not be able to take your camera into any of the buildings.
- Take off your shoes before entering any building.



From Suam Lum Night Bazaar, Bangkok Centre Hotel is just few minutes by MRT, take Lumpini station from the underground entrance point at Lumpini park and get down on Hua Lampong station, in front of the hotel.

Open from 5pm to midnight and later the "Suan Lum Night Bazaar" resembles something of a market mixed with a fairground in a park. It is more a night out and this can include a spot of shopping, a tasty meal from one of the many food vendors, and listening to some live entertainment.
